Carphone Warehouse hit with huge fine for data security breach

10 January 2018

Carphone Warehouse has been fined £400,000 by the Information Commissioner's Office for what was described as "serious failings" that placed customer and employee data at risk.

The retailer was issued with the penalty after one of its computer systems was compromised as a result of a cyber attack in 2015.

According to the ICO, Carphone Warehouse's failure to secure the system allowed unauthorised access to the personal data of more than three million customers and 1,000 employees.

'Visual Internet of Things' to harness petabytes of video data currently going to waste

Millions of hours of visual data captured in the UK every day are being wasted because businesses are failing to use or even look at their CCTV footage, says Cloudview.

According to the company there are currently around 8.2 million surveillance cameras across the country producing 10.3PB of visual data every hour.

It says most of this footage is stored locally and never looked at.
